"It shall be unlawful to permit any dog to defecate or urinate on the lawn or property of any but the owner, or upon any public or private property without the permission of the owner of that property"

Code of Ordinance section 91.20 paragraph (E).

With this being said, please be considerate to our neighbors and friends by taking the appropriate precautions to ensure that you clean up after your pets.
