- Currently applications are being accepted for the <u>priority group</u>, which is citizens 60 years old and over or those who are disabled and receiving services through the Division of Aging and Adult Services.
- * County mails LIEAP checks directly to vendor on behalf of approved recipients

 The Benefit amount is based on the household size and income.

Applications will be taken <u>January 1, 2016 through March 31, 2016</u> or until funds are exhausted for those outside of the *priority group*; when funds are exhausted program will end.
