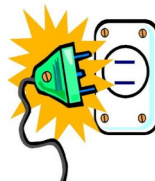
Low Income Energy Assistance Program

The Town of Winterville is pleased to share the following information provided by the Pitt County Department of Social Services:

The Low Income Energy Assistance Program, or LIEAP, administered by the Department of Social Services provides a one time, annual vendor payment to eligible families who need help with heating expenses.

- * Currently applications are being accepted for the *priority group*, which is **citizens 60 years old and over or those who are disabled and receiving services through the Division of Aging and Adult Services.**
- * County mails LIEAP checks directly to vendor on behalf of approved recipients. The Benefit amount is based on the household size and income.
