## **WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULES**

Please contact Public Works at (252)215-2412 for questions or concerns

**GARBAGE** – Roll out trash containers are picked up on WEDNESDAYS throughout the Town.

- Please put trash containers out the night before pickup.

**RECYCLABLES** – Recyclables (small cart) are picked up on TUESDAYS throughout the Town.

- Please put recycling carts out the night before pickup.
- SEE THE REVESE SIDE of this sheet for a LIST OF RECYCLABLE ITEMS that are accepted.

**BULKY ITEMS\*** – Bulky item pick-up is divided into 2 routes – Monday & Tuesday. (Bulky items will be collected the first (1st) and third (3rd) Mondays/Tuesdays of each month. If the month begins on a Tuesday, it will be the following week that begins on a Monday for the pickup to begin.)

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "Bulk Item / Const. Debris Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up date for your address.
- Bulky items include:
  - o Brown Goods small appliances that are primarily non-metal
  - o Furniture tables, chairs, mattresses, ect.
  - o Miscellaneous Items that do not fit into a garbage bag.

\*Bulky item debris may not be mixed with construction item debris.

**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS ITEMS\*** - Debris item pick-up is divided into 2 routes – Monday & Tuesday. (Construction debris items will be collected the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) and fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Mondays/Tuesdays of each month. If the month begins on a Tuesday, it will be the following week that begins on a Monday for the pickup to begin.)

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "Bulk Item / Const. Debris Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up date for your address.
- Construction debris items include:
  - Building Materials carpet, roofing materials, lumber, siding material, insulation, wall material, bricks, concrete, ceiling material, ect.

\*Construction debris may not be mixed with bulky item debris or any other solid waste material.

\*Town policy provides that only construction debris generated by the owner or resident of a property will be collected by the Town. Therefore, the Town cannot collect contractor-generated debris.

Newspaper, Magazines, Comics, Fliers & Inserts (No books or large catalogs) (Do not bundle or bag)

## PLASTIC #1 PETE

#1 Clear & Green Soda Bottles & Other Jars (Look for #1 on bottom of container. Please rinse & remove caps)

#### **STEEL CANS**

Food Cans (Please rinse & leave labels on cans. No aerosol or paint cans)

#### **PAPER & MAIL**

All White & Colored Paper (Paper received in mail, & school & office paper)

# **CARDBOARD**

Please flatten and place in Recycle Bin (No pizza or greasy boxes)

### PLASTIC #2 HDPE

#2 Milk, Detergent, Bleach & Other Bottles & Jugs (Look for #2 on bottom of container. Please rinse & remove caps. No motor oil or anti-freeze containers)

## <u>ALUMINUM</u>

Aluminum Beverage Cans (Beverage cans only. No aluminum foil or pie pans)

Beginning July 1, 2020 the Town of Winterville and Pitt County made significant changes to the way we recycle. Please note that glass is no longer an acceptable item. This streamlined list of recyclables is intended to keep the County's recycling program sustainable and contaminant-free. Please recycle ONLY the items listed above. Please do no include any trash (diapers, hoses, food scraps, or other items not listed above) in the recycling cart as these debris contaminate items that are recyclable and render them useless. Please do not bag recyclables within the recycle cart as this also leads to acceptable items being taken to the landfill instead of recycled.

GRASS & LEAVES - Grass & leaves pick-up is divided into 2 routes - Wednesday & Thursday

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "Grass & Leaves Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up date for your address.
- GRASS & LEAVES pick up include:
  - o Grass clippings, leaves, pine straw, ect.

\*DO NOT bag these items, as they will not be picked up by the Town if they are bagged. The leaf suction truck will be damaged if a bag is pulled up into the blower.

LIMBS\* – Limbs pick-up is divided into 3 routes – Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday.

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "Limbs Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up date for your address.
- LIMS pick up include:
  - o Limbs no greater than 6 ft. in length;
    - no larger than 6 in. in diameter;
    - this includes shrubs and bush limbs.

WHITE GOODS & TIRES – White Goods & Tires pick-up is on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of each month throughout the Town. (Tires must be removed from the rim.)

- White Goods include:
  - o metal appliances, large and small, such as televisions and computers
  - o no brown goods (see Debris items above)

\*note – If a pick-up route for a particular item is not completed on the scheduled pickup day, the route will be completed on the following day. If the route falls on a holiday, the items will be picked up on the following work day.

All items should be placed curbside, <u>behind the curbing</u>, for pickup. <u>Do not place</u> these items in the street. Placing items in the street may create a safety hazard for others. Leaves and grass clippings placed in the street may also block the Town storm water drainage system, thereby contributing to flooding. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

#### THE TOWN DOES NOT PROVIDE WASTE COLLECTION FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Tires still attached to the rim;
- Creosote treated lumber; salt treated lumber;
- Oil drums.

\*For construction debris, tree limbs, shrubs, bush limbs and wood that have been removed or cut down by <u>contactors</u>, it is the responsibility of the contractor to carry this material to the county or private waste collection sites.

\*Please place all items at the street prior to 7:00 am on your collection day.
