JULY UPDATE Winterville Utilities Electric Rate Change "Power Cost Adjustment (PCA)"

As everyone is aware, Winterville enacted a Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) to the Electric portion of the Town's Utility Bill in the Fall of 2022. This was done in an effort to keep the Town's financial position secure during the recent global events which has had an adverse impact on the costs of purchasing energy.

The original PCA was \$.05 per kWh. In March 2023, Town Council lowered the PCA to \$.025 per kWh. The PCA will now be lowered again to \$.015 per kWh, as some of the energy pricing increases have continued to decrease. The new lower rate will be reflected on your July 31st bill. The rate of \$.015 will remain in effect until December 31st, at that point in time it will be reviewed again.

The Town is committed to continually reviewing the energy market and making more positive adjustments to the PCA, as we are able to level the financial impact to the Town. Staff will continue to review all options available to the Town and will keep citizens aware as changes are made. Thank you for your continued patience during these challenging times!

Did You Know...

Most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the Town's sewer main? You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps:

- * Scrape excess grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage.
- Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes, or start a compost pile; promote use of scraping prior to washing.

Do Not

- Pour grease, fats, and oils from cooking down the
- Use the toilet as a wastebasket.
- Use the sewer as a means of disposing food scraps.

Yard Waste

Are You Contributing to Storm Drain Blockage?

If you are placing your grass clippings, leaves, limbs, or other debris on the sidewalks, streets, storm drains, or drainage ways; then the answer is yes. You are contributing to storm drain blockage. These not only create a visible nuisance, but it creates major problems.

Waste Pick Up By the Town

The Town of Winterville will **NOT** pick up any yard waste that is placed in the street. Yard waste must be placed behind the curb and away from utility poles and other services for the town to pick it up.

Chapter 98.028 of the Code of Ordinances prohibits placement of objects in streets, gutters, and other drainage ways.
