

BEWARE OF THE GREASE GOBLIN

Did You Know...

Most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the Town's sewer main? You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps:

Do

- Scrape excess grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage.
- Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes or start a compost pile; promote use of scraping prior to washing.
- Place a wastebasket in the bathroom to dispose of solid waste. Disposable diapers, condoms, and personal hygiene products do not belong in the sewer system.
- ♦ Promote the concept of "3 R's": Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

Do Not

- ♦ Pour grease, fats, and oils from cooking down the drain.
- Use the toilet as a wastebasket.
- Use the sewer as a means of disposing food scraps.

Yard Waste

- * Are You Contributing to Storm Drain Blockage?
- * If you are placing your grass clippings, leaves, limbs, or other debris in the streets, storm drains, or drainage ways; then the answer is yes. You are contributing to storm drain blockage. These not only create a visible nuisance, but it creates major problems:
- * It causes a traffic hazard due to vehicles turning out to miss it.
- * As it rains the waste is washed down into the storm drain system and builds up, which in turn causes flooding problems.
- * Do not place grass clipping, yards debris, or anything else in the storm drain ditches. These drainage ways must remain open and clear of debris to keep from flooding.

Yard Waste Pick Up By the Town

The Town of Winterville will NOT pick up any yard waste that is placed in the streets. Yard waste must be placed behind the curb and away from utility poles and other services for the town to pick it up. Chapter 98.028 of the Code of Ordinances prohibits placement of objects in streets, gutters, and other drainage ways.

Notification of Residential Garbage, Recycling, and Debris Collection Update

The Town of Winterville has made changes to the services provided for Solid Waste, Recycling, and Debris collection. Many of the changes are due to a new contracts that will allow the town to better service the citizens and eliminate many of the issues that have occurred historically. This includes **all new routes** for garbage collection, as well as, **reducing recycling collection to every other week**, and ending the construction debris route. The Town sought to make improvements and find ways to make sure the Sanitation Department was financially solvent, with the least amount of impact on the majority of our citizens. Please read. this Information carefully as there are a numerous changes. Below you will find details about the changes. You will also find maps that show what new route you will be assigned to, and your new garbage and recycling pick up days.



PLACEMENT OF TRASH AND RECYCLE BINS ON PICK-UP DATES

- * Please place your trash can and recycle bin at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.
- * Keep your containers at least four feet apart and at least four feet from any obstacles such as mail boxes, cars, lamp posts or power lines.
- * Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it has not been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes and we do not want you to be missed if we come later than expected.
- * It is generally best to put your container out the night before your collection day. That way even if we are early, your pick-up will not be missed.
