Winterville Police Senior Watch Program

- The Winterville Police Department believes in a "neighbor helping neighbor" concept and that is why the Winterville Police Senior Watch Program has been created for our elderly.
- Through these partnerships, we will strengthen our relationships between our neighbors and neighborhoods.
- Members can sign up themselves or by family filling out an application. The application is available at the Winterville Police Department.
- The "Senior Watch" program is for seniors who may need our help. These seniors may not have family to check on them or provide some assistance. The Police Department would visit the senior on a scheduled basis to check on their welfare.
- Once the application is received by the Police Department and approved, it is entered into our database and a schedule would be setup for the senior. As a part of the application process, a police official would meet with the senior for introductions.
- Officers will not be able to assist with medications or transportation.



The Town of Winterville has made changes to the services provided for Solid Waste, Recycling, and Debris collection. Many of the changes are due to a new contracts that will allow the town to better service the citizens and eliminate many of the issues that have occurred

historically. This includes all new routes for garbage collection, as well as, reducing recycling collection to every other week, and ending the construction debris route. The Town sought to make improvements and find ways to make sure the Sanitation Department was financially solvent, with the least amount of impact on the majority of our citizens. Please read. this Information carefully as there are a numerous changes. Below you will find details about the changes. You will also find maps that show what new route you will be assigned to, and your new garbage and recycling pick up days.

February Solid Waste Schedule

- Week of February 10th Trash and Recycling.
- ♦ Week of February 17th Trash Only.
- Week of February 24th Trash and Recycling


PLACEMENT OF TRASH AND RECYCLE BINS ON PICK-UP DATES

- * Please place your trash can and recycle bin at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.
- Keep your containers at least four feet apart and at least four feet from any obstacles such as mail boxes, cars, lamp posts or power

lines.

* Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it has not been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes and we do not want you to be missed if we come later than expected.

It is generally best to put your container out the night before your collection day. That way even if we are early, your pick-up will not be missed.



BEWARE OF THE GREASE GOBLIN

Did You Know...

Most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the Town's sewer main? You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps:

Do

- ♦ Scrape excess grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage.
- Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes or start a compost pile; promote use of scraping prior to washing.
- Place a wastebasket in the bathroom to dispose of solid waste. Disposable diapers, condoms, and personal hygiene products do not belong in the sewer system.
- ◆ Promote the concept of "3 R's": Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

Do Not

- ♦ Pour grease, fats, and oils from cooking down the drain.
- Use the toilet as a wastebasket.
- Use the sewer as a means of disposing food scraps.


