



## Walk & Roll to School Day – May 8, 2024 – AG Cox

### Goals:

- Spark initial enthusiasm for active mobility in our community of students and parents & kick off our Safe Routes to School program
- Introduce concepts like walking school buses/bike parades buses that could be implemented at other times during the school year
- Celebrate our three new temporary quick build intersection improvements

### Timetable

**7:20-7:40a** – Parents drop off students at southern end of Winterville Recreation Park along Division St

- Volunteers to receive and welcome students
- Volunteers to lead “stoke stations”:
  - Helmet fitting if needed
  - Reflective slap bracelets
  - Bike bells/lights

**7:45a** – Walking School Bus departs: Walking students begin 0.5 mi chaperoned walk to school (20 min to walk)

**7:50a** – Bike Train departs: Rolling students begin 0.6 mi chaperoned ride to school (15 min to ride). Bikes are stored in a secure area or locked upon arriving at school.

**8:05a** – Students arrive at school and are given stickers at the door (“I walked/rode to school!”)

**8:10a** – First bell
