<u>Tackle Football, Flag Football, Soccer, and Cheerleading – All Age Groups:</u>

Seasons delayed. Delayed season to begin in January and conclude no later than the first week in March. Online registration will remain open in preparation for delayed season start.

We are hopeful that we will be able offer these programs as proposed however, there is always the potential that league play is not possible. If delayed seasons are possible, rules, regulations, and guidelines will be followed with accompanying and pertinent restrictions in place.

We know and understand that participation in the proposed delayed season may not be desired and/or possible for currently registered participants.
