WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULES

GARBAGE - Roll-out trash containers are picked up on WEDNESDAYS throughout the Town.

- Please put trash containers out the night before pickup.

RECYCLABLES - Recyclables (small cart) are picked up on TUESDAYS throughout the Town.

- Please put recycling carts out the night before pickup.
- SEE THE REVERSE SIDE of this sheet for a LIST OF RECYCLABLE items that are accepted.

Bulky Items* - Bulky item pick-up is divided into 2 routes - Monday & Tuesday. (Bulky items will be collected the first (1st) & third (3rd) Mondays/Tuesdays of each month. If the month begins on a Tuesday it will be the following week that begins on a Monday for the pickup to begin.)

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "**Bulky & Const. Debris** Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up day for your address.

- Bulky items include:

Brown Goods - small appliances that are primarily non-metal such as TV's, stereos, microwaves, etc.

Furniture - tables, chairs, mattresses, etc.

Miscellaneous Items - that do not fit into a garbage bag.

***Bulky item debris may not be mixed with construction item debris.**

Construction Debris Items* - Debris item pick-up is divided into 2 routes - Monday & Tuesday. (Construction debris items will be collected the second (2nd) & fourth (4th) Mondays/Tuesdays of each month. If the month begins on a Tuesday it will be the following week that begins on a Monday for the pickup to begin.)

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "**Bulky & Const. Debris** Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up day for your address.

- Const. Debris items include:

Building Materials - carpet, roofing materials, lumber, siding Material, insulation, wall material, bricks, Concrete, ceiling material, etc.

***Construction debris may not be mixed with bulky item debris or any other solid waste material.**

***Town policy provides that only construction debris generated by the owner or resident of a property will be collected by the Town. Therefore, the Town cannot collect contractor generated debris.**

GRASS & LEAVES* - Grass & leaves pick-up is divided into 2 routes - Wednesday & Thursday.

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "**GRASS & LEAVES** Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up day for your address.

- GRASS & LEAVES pick up includes:

Grass Clippings, Leaves, & Pine straw.

***DO NOT bag these items, as they will not be picked up by the Town if they are bagged. The leaf suction truck will be damaged if a bag is pulled up into the blower.**

LIMBS* - Limbs pick-up is divided into 3 routes - Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday.

- SEE THE ATTACHED MAP labeled "**LIMBS** Pick-up Routes" to determine the pick-up day for your address.

- LIMBS pick up includes:

Limbs - no greater than 6 ft. in length;
- no larger than 6 in. in diameter;
- this includes shrubs and bush limbs.

***note** - *If a pick-up route for a particular item is not completed on the scheduled pick-up day, the route will be completed on the following day. If the route falls on a holiday the pickup schedule will be adjusted for that week. - SEE CALENDER FOR ADJUSTED SCHEDULE.*

WHITE GOODS & Tires - White Goods & Tires pick-up is on the 2nd Friday of each month throughout the Town. **(Tires must be removed from the rim)**

- **You will need to call the Town at 215-2347** prior to the second Friday of the month to let us know that you have white goods or tires to be picked up in order for a pickup to be scheduled.

White Goods include:

- metal appliances, large and small
 - no brown goods (see Debris items above)
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All items should be placed at curbside, **behind the curbing**, for pickup. **Do not** place these items in the street. Placing items in the street may create a safety hazard for others. Leaves and grass clippings placed in the street may also block the Town storm water drainage system, thereby contributing to flooding. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

THE TOWN DOES NOT PROVIDE WASTE COLLECTION FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Tires **still attached to the rim;**
- Creosote treated lumber; Salt treated lumber
- Oil drums

***Construction debris, tree limbs, shrubs, bush limbs and wood that have been removed or cut down by contractors, it is the responsibility of the contractor to carry this material to the county or private waste collection sites.**

***Please place all items at the street prior to 7:00 am on your collection day.**

PICK UP CARDBOARD.** You may take
corrugated cardboard for recycling
to any of the Pitt County Waste
Collection sites, such as the one
located on Reedy Branch Road by the
Winterville Cemetery.

PLASTIC #2 HDPE

#2 Milk, Detergent, Bleach
& other Bottles & Jugs
(Look for #2 on bottom of
container. Please rinse &
removed caps. No motor oil
or anti-freeze containers.)

GLASS

Clear, Brown & Green
Bottles & Jars
(Please rinse & remove lids.
No bulbs, ceramics or blue
Glass)

Aluminum

Aluminum Beverage Cans
(Beverage cans only. No
aluminum foil or pie pans)

Under a new State law, which becomes effective October 1, 2009, North Carolina will be banning all rigid plastic containers from landfills. This includes any bottle with a neck smaller than the container itself.

The legislation, which was adopted in 2005, and will focus largely on the recovery of Polyethylene terephthalate (PETE). This plastic, commonly identified by the number "1" inside a recycling symbol on the bottle, is the resin of choice for most soda and water bottles.

In addition to plastic bottles the legislation also bans motor vehicle oil filters and wooden pallets, also effective October 1, 2009.

In order to facilitate your recycling and in response to the many requests for a larger recycling container, the Town has arranged with our contractor, Waste Industries, to provide each home participating in trash collection with a larger (64 gallon cart) container at no additional cost. Not only does this cart provide more capacity, but it also has a lid that will prevent trash from getting wet or blown out during windy days.
