Fire Hydrant Clearance Requirements

In a fire, seconds count, and water to fight the fire is one of the most important pieces to help save lives when an emergency occurs. In the Town of Winterville, we follow the NC Fire Code requirements that mandate that

hydrants have a 36" clearance (3 ft.) around the entire hydrant. We also must be able to make hose connections to our fire engines from the hydrants, so therefore, the hydrant outlets must be above the ground at a point where we can make these connections easily.

Although hydrants may not be considered aesthetically pleasing, remember that hydrants are there for an important reason. Covering or placing items near or around fire hydrants means our community has hydrants that do NOT meet these necessary requirements. The Town is asking that all residents help us keep them safe by making sure that the fire code mandates listed above are followed on your property. If you have questions, or need help with clearing vegetation around your hydrants, please contact us, and we will be glad to provide assistance. The number to call is 252-215-2476 for any advice or assistance in the mission to keep everyone safe by having clear access to the firefighting resource that fire hydrants provide. Thank you!!

<u>Construction Debris</u> pick-up is divided into 2 routes— Monday & Tuesday. (Construction Debris will be collected the 2nd & 4th Mondays/Tuesdays of each month. If the month begins on a Tuesday it will be the following week that begins on a Monday for the pickup to begin).

GRASS & LEAVES

Grass & Leaves pick-up is divided into 2 routes— Wednesday & Thursday. Please see the Town's web site to determine the day of your pick-up.

**DO NOT bag these items, as they will not be picked up by the Town if they are bagged. The leaf suction truck will be damaged if a bag is pulled up into the blower.
