

# SANITATION ROUTES

The Town would like to remind our residents of our route changes during the holiday season. During the week of December 24th - 26th our offices will be closed Monday thru Wednesday for the Christmas Holiday. We will return on Thursday, December 27th. Please see the following adjustments to the regularly scheduled debris routes:

- Regularly scheduled *construction debris* route for Monday December 24th will run on Thursday December 27th.
- ⇒ Regularly scheduled *construction debris* route for Tuesday December 25th will run on Friday December 28th.
- ⇒ Regularly scheduled *limb route* for Monday December 24th will run on Thursday December 27th.
- ⇒ Regularly scheduled *limb route* for Tuesday December 25th will run on Thursday December 27th.
- Regularly scheduled *limb route* for Wednesday December 26th will run on Friday December 28th.
- ⇒ Regularly scheduled grass and leaves route for Wednesday December 26th will run on Thursday December 27th and Thursday's route will run on Friday December 28th.
- $\Rightarrow$  Waste Industries will run a day behind, recyclables will run on Wednesday and garbage service will run on Thursday throughout the holidays.
