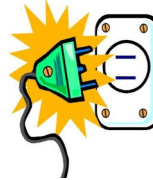


# Winterville at Work!

## Low Income Energy Assistance Program

The Town of Winterville is pleased to shared the following information provided by the Pitt County Department of Social Services:

ELECTRICITY



The Low Income Energy Assistance Program, or LIEAP, administered by the Department of Social Services provides a one time, annual vendor payment to eligible families who need help with heating expenses.

- \* Currently applications are being accepted for the priority group, which is **citizens 60 years old and over or those who are disabled and receiving services through the Division of Aging and Adult Services.**
- \* County mails LIEAP checks directly to vendor on behalf of approved recipients. The Benefit amount is based on the household size and income.

### WHEN APPLICATIONS WILL BE TAKEN

Applications will be taken December 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017 or until funds are exhausted for those outside of the priority group; when funds are exhausted program will end.

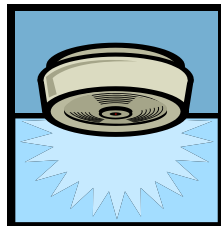
