

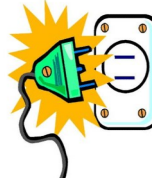
# Winterville at Work!

## Low Income Energy Assistance Program

The Town of Winterville is pleased to share the following information provided by the Pitt County Department of Social Services:

The Low Income Energy Assistance Program, or LIEAP, administered by the Department of Social Services provides a one time, annual vendor payment to eligible families who need help with heating expenses.

**ELECTRICITY**



\* Currently applications are being accepted for the priority group, which is **citizens 60 years old and over or those who are disabled and receiving services through the Division of Aging and Adult Services.**

\* County mails LIEAP checks directly to vendor on behalf of approved recipients. The Benefit amount is based on the household size and income.

**WHEN APPLICATIONS WILL BE TAKEN:** Applications will be taken December 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019 or until funds are exhausted for those outside of the priority group; when funds are exhausted, program will end. Monday - Friday 8 AM until 5 PM

### HOW TO PREVENT SANITARY SEWER BACKUPS...

Did You Know...

Most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the Town's sewer main? You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps:

#### DO

- ✓ Scrape excess grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage.
- ✓ Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes, or start a compost pile; promote use of scraping prior to washing.

- ✓ Place a wastebasket in the bathroom to dispose of disposable diapers, condoms, personal hygiene products, and flushable wipes that do not belong in the sewer system.

#### DO NOT

**\*\* Flushable wipes cause major issues clogging the sewer pumps PLEASE DO NOT Flush "FLUSHABLE WIPES" \*\***

- Ø Pour grease, fats, and oils from cooking down the drain.
- Ø Use the toilet as a wastebasket.
- Ø Use the sewer as a means of disposing of food scraps.
