# Winterville at Work!



Cooking equipment is the leading cause of home fires and fire injuries. Ranges or cooktops account for the majority (62%) of hor cooking fires, with unattended frying dominating the cooking fire problem.

#### What you should know about home cooking safety...

Be on alert! Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling, boiling, or broiling food. Keep anything that can catch fire — oven mitts, wooden utensils, food packaging, towels or curtains — away from your stovetop.

#### If you have a cooking fire ...

Just get out! When you leave, close the door behind you to help contain the fire. Call 9-1-1 after you leave. DO NOT attempt to fight the fire unless properly trained to do so! DO NOT use water on a fire on the stove as this will cause the fire to potentially flash and spread in the kitchen causing burns to skin with potential life threatening consequences. A fire extinguisher or a box of household baking soda are two of the best options to extinguish a fire on the stove. For an oven fire, turn off the heat and keep the door closed.

#### General grilling safety tips ...

Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors. The grill should be placed well away from the home. Keep children and pets away from the grilling area. Never leave your grill unattended.

#### Charcoal grills ...

- If you use a starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire.
- When you are finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.
