We ask that gift(s) be dropped off at the Winterville Operations Center by application deadline, November 19th the Winterville Operations Center is located at 2936 Church Street, Winterville, NC 28590; office hours are Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Office will be closed Monday, November 12th in observance of Veteran's Day.

Winterville Tree Lighting Ceremony & Town Council Reception. Come join the Mayor, Town Council, Town Employees, and citizens of Winterville for the annual Winterville Tree Lighting Ceremony. The Tree Lighting Ceremony is on **November 29th at 6:00 p.m.** and features Christmas Carols, gift card giveaways, reading of *The Night Before Christmas* by Mayor Doug Jackson, and the lighting of the Winterville Christmas Tree located at 252 Main Street or the Winterville Town Square across from the Winterville Fire Department. The **Winterville Town Council Reception** will follow the Tree Lighting Ceremony at the Winterville Fire Department located at 2593 Railroad Street. Guests will be treated to snacks and refreshments!

THE SEASON OF LEAVES

The cooler fall weather brings forth the season of leaves! Please help the Public Works Department by following our collection rules and regulations. This will make the busy collection of leaves smoother and will reduce costly repairs to our suction machine. **Reminder...Please do not put grass clippings, metal, or household items in your recycle bins due to contamination and the Landfill refusing to allow trucks to unload.**



General Rules for the Collection of LEAVES:

- * **ALL YARD WASTE** items should be placed at curbside, behind the curbing for pickup. **Do not place items in the street.** As a friendly reminder to our citizens, it is against Town Ordinance 98.028 to rake, blow, mow or move grass, grass clippings and leaves into any Town street, sidewalk, gutter or drainage way. This will eventually lead to the blocking of the Town's storm drainage system. **Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.**
- * Please **do not place LEAVES in trash cans, bags, or other containers.** In addition, please ensure that there are no limbs or other yard debris among the grass, leaves, or pine straw pile. **Items such as limbs or bags will cause damage to the suction truck which proves costly to repair.**
- * Specific routes with days for leaf pickup can be found under the Public Works section of the website. www.wintervillenc.com
- * Please know that if your debris pile is not picked up on the scheduled day, we probably are behind on our routes and will get to your location as soon as possible.
