



Walk and Roll to School Day – May 8, 2024 – WH Robinson

Goals:

- Spark initial enthusiasm for active mobility in our community of students and parents & kick off our Safe Routes to School program
- Introduce concepts like walking/biking schools buses that could be implemented at other times during the school year
- Celebrate our three new temporary quick build intersection improvements

Timetable:

6:50-7:10a – Parents drop off students at entrance to Hillcrest Park along Hillcrest Ave

- Volunteers to receive and welcome students
- Volunteers to lead “stoke stations”:
 - Sidewalk chalk drawing
 - Traffic garden open-play zone
 - Helmets for students who need one (check inventory with PE teachers)
 - Reflective slap bracelets

7:15-7:30a – Walking School Bus departs: Hillcrest walkers begin 0.3 mi chaperoned walk to school (allowing 15 min to walk)

7:20-7:30a – Bike Parade departs: Hillcrest bikers begin 0.7 mi chaperoned ride to school (allowing 10 min to ride). Bikes are stored in a secure area or locked upon arriving at school.

7:30a – Students arrive at school and are given stickers at the door by volunteers (“I walked/rode to school!”)

Materials (most provided by SRTS coordinator):

- Giveaway items
 - Reflective slap bracelets
 - Helmets (ask PE teachers)
 - Stickers
- Megaphone or microphone

- Temporary bike racks at school?
- Signs for volunteers (“Walking School Bus”, “Bike Parade”)
- Safety vests for volunteers
- Sidewalk chalk
