The County accepts additional items at the convenience drop-off sites, but, not in the recycle cart.

ALSO ACCEPTED

The following materials also are accepted for recycling and proper disposal at the county convenience drop-off sites and Transfer Station. For additional restrictions, see the site attendant or visit the website.



Used cooking oil (site 3 and Transfer Station only)



Used motor oil, filters, car batteries



Bulk items (furniture, chairs, etc.)



Large appliances (fridges, washing machines, etc.)



Electronics (computers, TV's, etc.)



Leaves, pine straw, brush, grass, small tree limbs



Clothing and textiles, shoes and prescription eyeglasses



Household trash

In addition, the Transfer Station also accepts thermostats, tires, anti-freeze, construction and demolition (concrete/brick, pallets, shingles, etc.) and latex paint.

Winterville Police Senior Watch Program



- The Winterville Police Department believes in a "neighbor helping neighbor" concept and that is why the Winterville Police Senior Watch Program has been created for our elderly.
- Through these partnerships, we will strengthen our relationships between our neighbors and neighborhoods.
- Members can sign up themselves or by family filling out an application. The application is available at the Winterville Police Department.
- The "Senior Watch" program is for seniors who may need our help. These seniors may not have family to check on them or provide some assistance. The Police Department would visit the senior on a scheduled basis to check on their welfare.
- Once the application is received by the Police Department and approved, it is entered into our database and a schedule would be setup for the senior. As a part of the application process, a police official would meet with the senior for introductions.
- Officers will not be able to assist with medications or transportation.
