

PLACEMENT OF TRASH AND RECYCLE BINS ON PICK-UP DATES

- * Please place your trash can and recycle bin at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.
- * Keep your containers at least four feet apart and at least four feet from any obstacles such as mail boxes, cars, lamp posts or power lines.
- * Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it has not been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes and we do not want you to be missed if we come later than expected.
- * It is generally best to put your container out the night before your collection day. That way even if we are early, your pick-up will not be missed.



Safety Tips for Both Pedestrians & Drivers in the Town of Winterville: SAFETY HABITS



Tips for DRIVERS that may help alert them to increase caution.

- When you see pedestrians walking slow down.
- Crosswalks serve as symbol that walkers are near.
- Slow down when you notice Reflective Vests in the distance.
- Ensure your vehicle is operating properly.
- Slow down in neighborhoods as it is increasingly likely to have walkers.
- Always be mindful of your speed and stop and check for pedestrians in neighborhoods.

Tips for PEDESTRIANS that may help alert them to stay visible & safe while walking

- Walk in lighted areas.
- Never assume a driver sees you, walk with caution.
- If possible, make eye contact with drivers.
- Wear a reflective vest when walking after dusk or during the evening
- Try to avoid walking in the middle of a street/road. Walk on the side, closest to the curb.
