Notification of Residential Garbage, Recycling, and Debris Collection Update

The Town of Winterville has made changes to the services provided for Solid Waste, Recycling, and Debris collection. Many of the changes are due to a new contracts that will allow the town to better service the citizens and eliminate many of the issues that have occurred historically. This includes **all new routes** for garbage collection, as well as, **reducing recycling collection to every other week**, and ending the construction debris route. The Town sought to make improvements and find ways to make sure the Sanitation Department was financially solvent, with the least amount of impact on the majority of our citizens. Please read this information carefully as there are a numerous changes. Below you will find details about the changes. You will also find maps that show what new route you will be assigned to, and your new garbage and recycling pick up days.

December Solid Waste Schedule

- ◆ Week of December 2nd - Trash and Recycling.
- ◆ Week of December 9th - Trash Only.
- ◆ Week of December 16th - Trash and Recycling.
- ◆ Week of December 23rd - Trash Only. (Holiday Week).
- ◆ Week of December 30th - Trash and Recycling (Holiday Week).



- Toys
- Ceramic items
- Medical waste
- Cleaning or textiles
- Plastic bags/wrap
- Diapers
- Scrap metal/wood
- Disposable cups (plastic and paper)
- Styrofoam/peanuts
- Electronics
- Tanglers
- Food-tainted items (cork, bees, wine, etc.)
- Glass bottles and jars



PLACEMENT OF TRASH AND RECYCLE BINS ON PICK-UP DATES

- * Please place your trash can and recycle bin at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.
- * Keep your containers at least four feet apart and at least four feet from any obstacles such as mail boxes, cars, lamp posts or power lines.
- * Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it has not been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes and we do not want you to be missed if we come later than expected.
- * It is generally best to put your container out the night before your collection day. That way even if we are early, your pick-up will not be missed.
