



Did You Know...Most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the Town's sewer main?

You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps.

Town of Winterville Urgent Repair Program

You must meet our basic qualifications:

1. Live in the home you own or have life estate/rights that is located within the municipal limits of the Town of Winterville.
2. The home to be repaired is not a mobile home.
3. You are up to date and/or have an executed payment plan on the property taxes for the Town and County at your home.
4. Your household qualifies as low-income (according to HUD annual guidelines).
5. Someone in your home is elderly (+62), a person with a disability, or a child under the age of 18.
6. Agree to an 8-year recapture agreement to be prorated for the amount of improvements.
7. Consideration is given first to households that have not yet received any services, as well as seniors, persons with disabilities, and families with children who are unable to make their own repairs and who have no able-bodied family members to assist them.
8. Income Eligibility (50% median income level for Pitt County).
9. Income verification must be provided with the application.
10. Applications are available at Town Hall.
