\$2.2 Million in Funding Secured for Winterville

Congressman Gregory F. Murphy, M.D., was honored to present a \$2.2 million federal check to the Town of Winterville that he secured through last year's appropriations process. These funds will support critical upgrades to Winterville's water infrastructure, including improvements to three water main lines and the acquisition of a new water storage system. Mosquito Season is here!

The Town asks that residents look to find and empty any containers or standing water on their property. This is where mosquitos lay their eggs and where the larva hatch. The mosquito monitoring program has begun to keep the population under control. The 3 D's of protection:



Drain:

- **Dispose** of old tires. Tires can breed thousands of mosquitos; **Dump** standing water in buckets, flowerpots and planters, children's toys and tarps or pool covers; **Clean** out gutters, unclog drains; and pet water dishes and bird baths.

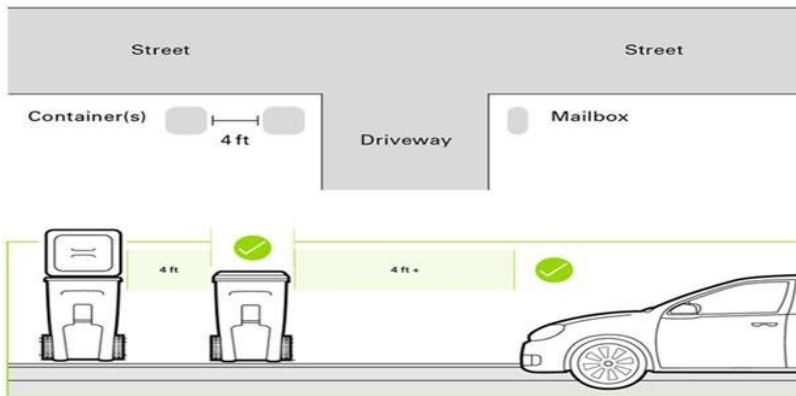
Dress:

- **Wear** light colored, loose fitting clothing, long sleeves and pants are recommended when outdoors, especially at dawn and dusk.

Defend:

- **Use EPA-registered** insect repellents with DEET, picaridin, or oil of lemon eucalyptus; **Report** areas of standing water to local vector control; **Stay informed** about local mosquito control programs and participate when possible.
