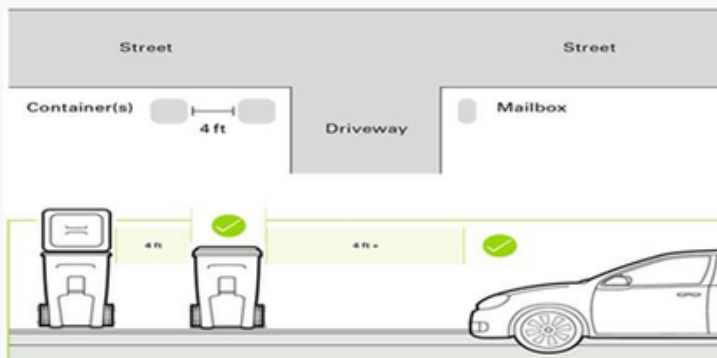
- Week of September 28th: Trash Only.

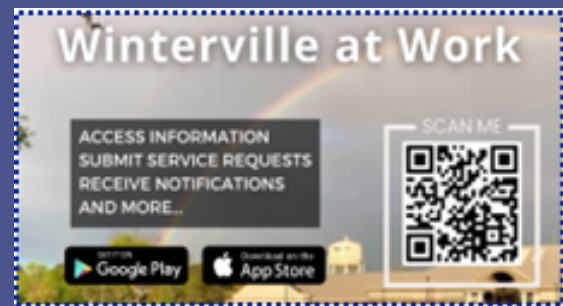

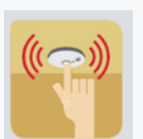

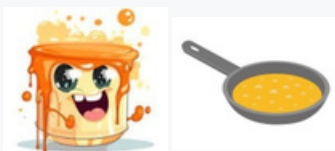
