



Mosquito Season and Town Spraying is here!

The Town is now spraying and asks that residents look to find and empty any containers or standing water on their property. This is where mosquitos lay their eggs and where the larva hatch. The mosquito monitoring and spraying program has begun to keep the population under control. The 3 D's of protection - Drain, Dress and Defend:

Drain:

- Dispose of old tires. Tires can breed thousands of mosquitos.
- Dump standing water in buckets, flowerpots and planters, children's toys and tarps or pool covers.
- · Clean out gutters and unclog drains.
- · Clean pet water dishes and bird baths regularly.

Dress:

- Wear light colored, loose fitting clothing.
- Long sleeves and pants are recommended when outdoors, especially at dawn and dusk.

Defend:

- Use EPA-registered insect repellents with DEET, picaridin, or oil of lemon eucalyptus.
- Report areas of standing water to local vector control.
- Stay informed about local mosquito control programs and participate when possible.



Winterville Police Senior Watch Program



- Through these partnerships, we will strengthen our relationships between our neighbors and neighborhoods.
- Members can sign up themselves or by family filling out an application. The application is available at the Winterville Police Department.
- The "Senior Watch" program is for seniors who may need our help. These seniors may not have family to check on them or provide some assistance. The Police Department would visit the senior on a scheduled basis to check on their welfare.
- Once the application is received by the Police Department and approved, it is entered into our database and a schedule would be setup for the senior. As a part of the application process, a police official would meet with the senior for introductions.
- Officers will not be able to assist with medications or transportation.
