Winterville Electric Power Cost Adjustment



As a result of the extreme cold weather that hit the Northeast United States earlier this year, the cost the Town pays for natural gas drastically increased.

The Town currently purchases its power from Kings Mountain Energy Center (a combined cycle natural gas generation plant) located in Kings Mountain, North Carolina. To help cover the increased cost of natural gas and to keep the Town’s Electric Fund financially secure, the Town adopted a Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) of 5 cent per kWh for the utility bills that were billed in March.

The PCA was reduced from 5 cent per kWh to 2.5 cent per kWh beginning with the utility bills that were billed in April and due on April 30th for cycle 2 customers and due on May 15th for cycle 1 customers.

Due to the natural gas prices recently decreasing, the Town plans to end the PCA on July 1, 2026.

We realize that this increase will be an unpleasant change for our customers, so please know that we appreciate your patience as we continue to monitor the prices.
