The Town Staff would like to remind everyone of the ordinance that relates to the maintenance of your property:

Section 95.015 WEEDS, VEGETATION AND OTHER PUBLIC HEALTH NUISANCES

Weeding and tidying of premises, cutting of right-of-way required. Any person owning real property within the Town is hereby required to:

Cut and remove therefrom all weeds and grass, from both the property and the adjoining right-of-way, before it reaches a height of (8) eight inches;

Nuisances Prohibited; enumeration. The following enumerated and described conditions are hereby found, deemed and declared to constitute a detriment, danger and hazard to the health and safety of the inhabitants of the town; and are found, deemed and declared to be a public nuisance wherever the same may exist, and the creation, maintenance, or failure to abate any nuisance is hereby declared unlawful:

Any condition that has become, or will become if not corrected, a breeding ground or harbor for mosquitoes, rats or other pest;

A place of heavy growth of weeds, grasses, vines, or other vegetation over (8) eight inches in height;

****Reminder DO NOT put grass clippings, shrubbery or limbs in your Recycling Containers**

The Pulse of the Police – June, 2019



Welcome all to the June 2019 edition of the Winterville Police Department Community Newsletter. We are excited to inform you that two of our Police officers participated in a bicycle ride from Raleigh N.C. to Washington D.C. This ride, conducted every year during National Police week, features countless law enforcement agencies from across the nation descending on our nation's capital. In 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a law designating May 15 as Peace Officers' Memorial Day, and the week in which May 15 falls as National Police Week. This allows officers and citizens alike, time to pause and remember fallen officers and their families left behind. We are proud that two Winterville Police officers have joined in such a noble event.

I would like to publically commend our investigations unit on solving the stolen mail case. Over the last several months, citizens have reported mail missing from their mailbox or notified by their banking institution of fraudulent activity. Winterville Police, along with Ayden Police and the US Postal inspector arrested Ms. Hollie Chaimowitz on the morning of Thursday, May 2nd, 2019. A search of her car and residence located in Ayden yielded 21 stolen checks totaling \$11,220.65. Also recovered were stolen credit cards, and a stolen wallet. Of the 21 stolen checks, 10 of those checks were that of Winterville residents. The other victims were from Greenville, Goldsboro, and Washington.

As a friendly reminder, please keep your dogs on their leash. It is a Town ordinance violation for your dog to be off leash and not on your property. We have had some instances of folks walking their dog and encountering an unleashed dog. This is dangerous, as we do not know the temperament of all of our furry friends. This poses a hazard to the animals and our citizens alike.

Finally, June is National Safety Month and our officers are focusing on reducing leading causes of property damage and injury in our communities and roadways. Speed and Impairment are at the top of that list. Officers will be working hard keeping all of our citizens safe. Have a great start to your summer and "think" safety.
